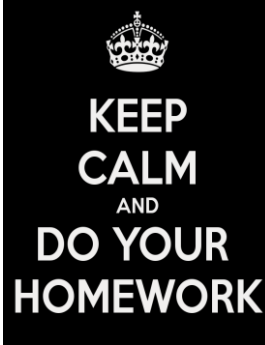

- Take out Homework

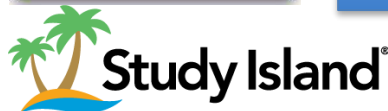
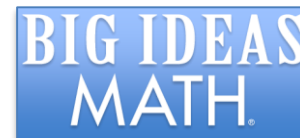
During Class
